All sections not modified below shall incorporate by reference the Yacht Racing Association of Long Island Sound, Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, 2016 Western and Mid-Sound One-Design

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in: The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the applicable one-design class association rules, ISAF Regulation 22 as it applies to class rules, YRALIS One-Design Championship Rules, and for all classes, the Minimum Equipment Recommendations of the YRALIS (Category C).

2 ENTRIES

The following shall be added: The attached entry form must be completed and received by American Yacht Club by fax or in person before 1900 on July 1st, 2016.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES

Races for all classes will be run on July 2nd and July 3rd. More than one race may be held on any day at the sole discretion of the Race Committee. The first warning signal is scheduled to be made at 1255 each day. There will be two separate courses to accommodate all classes. The South Course will accommodate the following classes, Etchells-22 who will race as Division 1, code flag 1. IOD class will race as Division 2, code flag 2. Shields class will be Division 3, code flag 3. S-boats will be division 4, code flag 4. The East Course will accommodate the following classes, J/70's will race in Division 1, code flag 1. Viper's will race in Division 2, code flag 2 and the K-6 fleet will race in Division 3, code flag 3. Code flags do not need to be flown from individual yachts but are referenced for starting sequence.

4 RACING AREA

Races will be conducted from a starting area located approximately mid-Sound, south of Milton Point, Rye, New York. The approximate positions of the starting areas will be announced at 1200 each day for all classes on VHF channel 68.

5 SCORING

Multiple races are scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series.

6 PRIZES

Series prizes for each class will be awarded as follows: a first place prize for two or more entries; second place for four or more; and third place for six or more.

Prizes will be awarded following the conclusion of racing on Sunday. If yacht owners are unable to attend the awards, Prizes will be sent by mail to the name and address listed on the entry form. If no entry form or regatta fee has been submitted, the prize will go to the next place finisher who has submitted a valid entry form and regatta fee.

The scores from this series shall be included in the season scores described in Section 14 of the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, 2016 Mid-Sound One-Design.

7 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY/RESPONSIBILITY FOR SAFETY

By participating in this event and any related activity sponsored or undertaken by American Yacht Club, the owner, helmsman and each crew member agree: that they understand that sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of serious bodily injury (including permanent disability, paralysis and death by drowning or otherwise), property damage and other economic loss; that the safety of the boat and her crew and the decision whether or not to start or continue to race is solely their responsibility and at their own risk, see RRS 4 "Decision to Race"; that American Yacht Club and its officers, trustees, members, committees, employees or agents will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property, or to any participant, including injury or death; and that each of them releases and waives all claims which he or she, or any heir, representative, successor or assignee, may have against American Yacht Club and its officers, trustees, members, committees, employees or agents, arising out of or in any way connected with participation in such race or activity.
