



2022 OGYC Sail Fleet Coaching Policy

OGYC sail fleet coaching is available at OGYC for a minimum of 1.5 hours at \$127.50 for a private one-on-one coaching with the instructor. Group coaching is available for two sailors per boat at \$187.50 for 1.5 hours. Members are responsible for their own pairing. Additional time will be billed at an hourly fee of \$85/hour for private coaching and \$125/hour for group coaching. A 15% administration fee will be added to cover miscellaneous employee expenses.

A private coaching session can only accommodate one sailor and the coach in the boat at one time. A group coaching session can accommodate two sailors and the coach in the boat at one time. All participants must wear a mask at all times while on the dock, on the launch and in the boat. All participants must wear a USCG approved PFD.

All sailors must be 18 or over.

Coaching is available for all levels of sailors, from beginner to advanced racing, spinnaker, rules, tactics, starts, sail trim, etc.

Member pre-requisites include attending a low water harbor tour and signing the 2022 fleet-use agreement. Prior to the session, the OGYC sailing director may review the club database of certification status for compliance. A record of this will also be located in the fleet logbook for the coach to review. For children over the age of 18, the parent member shall have taken a low water tour and signed the 2022 sail fleet agreement. The parent member shall take full responsibility for the child at the helm.

A member can register for a coaching event by going to OGYC.org on the calendar dates where coaching sessions are scheduled. These events are scheduled at times that do not conflict with other OGYC sanctioned events that includes racing, woman's sailing, GCS weekend checkout rides, and education events.

Recommended days for private and group coaching are Tuesdays (12:00 pm – 7:30 pm) and Saturdays (12:00pm - 5:00pm). Times will be adjusted as needed depending on time of sunset and demand for additional time slots. Afternoon and early evening time slots may have better wind options.

Coaching fees will be collected from the member at the time of registration and coaching will be direct billed to any member who reserves this service based upon the number of hours coaching is taking place.



There are no refunds for member “no-shows” so please be on time for your session. In the event of a “no-show” no future events can be scheduled for this member unless an agreement to do so is approved by the sailing coach.

In the event of poor weather or other circumstances where the member is not able to make the appointment, the member is obligated to notify the coach at least 24 hours in advance to cancel by emailing coach at annemunckenbeck@optonline.net. Any cancellation after this point will result in no credit or refund.

Boats can only be sailed in the weather conditions set forth in the fleet use agreement. In the event that a session is canceled (day of) due to bad weather, the member and the coach will be responsible for re-scheduling the session or, an alternative lesson plan will be available on land. In addition, if it is clear one day in advance that bad weather most likely will force a cancellation of the on the water lesson, there will be an option for an alternative lesson on land but must be confirmed 24 hours in advance.

Reservation and Billing will be managed as follows:

Member registers for event on line. Payment is then collected on line, no cash payments only credit card.

Ideal 1 is Reserved for Sail Fleet Coaching Lessons. Prior to departing, members shall note the reservation for Ideal 1 in the checkout logbook located in the clubhouse. It is the responsibility of each registrant to sign the boat back in upon return.

At the completion of the lesson, the coach will send OGYC’s sailing director the number of hours and members name. In the event the session exceeds the original reservation, the coach will note the additional time and obtain signature from the member for the added time either on or off the water and send that to the sailing director so that this information can be sent to the club Administrator for member billing.

Rates are subject to change annually based on those set forth by the coach and will be reflected on the registration.
